Winter Safety: What you need to know



Winter time is here and getting colder. It's important to maintain safety when going outdoors in the winter cold and snow. Here are a few ways to stay safe in the cold:

- * Establish a buddy system- friends and family can help look out for each other.
- * Check often to see if children are warm and dry.
- * Use sunscreen- even when cold, uv rays can be harmful
- * Dress in layers to keep warm and cover exposed skin to protect from frostbite.
- * Wear a hat- a lot of body heat is lost through your head.
- * Remove all wet clothing and boots after playing in snow
- * Snowballs are fun, but keep them away from faces.

Want to have a little extra fun in the snow? Learning and exploring with a little science experiment? Here is a fun little expirement to try in the snowy weather.

What you need:

- -16oz plastic bottle (emptied)
- -1/4 cup baking soda in a seperate
- 1 cup white vinegar
- Funnel or paper rolled into a funnel
- Food coloring
- Snow
- #1: Pour 1 cup of vinegar in the plastic bottle
- #2: Add a couple drops of vinegar to the bottle
- #3: Put the funnel/ paper funnel in the mouth of the plastic bottle
- #4: Go outside and form a cone around the plastic bottle in the snow- be sure not to cover the mouth of the plastic bottle. #5: Pour the backing soda into the funnel/plastic bottle and stand back... watch the snow volcano erupt.
