# Bright Eyes Early Learning Center All-Star Summer Contract

- 1. A \$50 non-refundable field trip/t-shirt fee is required for all children. Field trip/t-shirt fees do not apply for campers only attending the last week of the summer program
- 2. An additional \$50 enrollment fee is required <u>and</u> a one week deposit for all children <u>not</u> currently enrolled in Bright Eyes. Spaces will not be held without completed registration paperwork and fees.
- 3. I agree to pay all fees based on the fee scale on the reverse side without dispute.
- 4. If my child does not attend any week that has been signed up for, I understand that I am responsible for tuition payment for that week.
- 5. There are no refunds or discounts for absences, vacations, emergency closings, and/or holidays.
- 6. All children must be picked up by 6:30pm, or a late pickup fee of \$5 per every 10 minutes, or portion thereof, per child, will be charged.
- 7. Children attending the 9am-3:30pm program may be dropped off in the classroom no more than 10 minutes before 9am, and must be picked up by 3:30pm. Late fee charges will apply after 3:30pm. If a field trip runs later than 3:30pm, you will be notified by management and <u>will not</u> be charged late charge fees.
- 8. There is a \$30 fee for checks returned by the bank. After two returned checks, cash payments will be required.
- 9. Payments are due on Monday of each week, or the first day of the week that your child attends. A \$5 late payment fee will be charged for each day after that. If payment is not received by Friday of the week due, your child's enrollment may be terminated.
- 10. All children not currently enrolled in Bright Eyes will need to provide Bright Eyes with the necessary paperwork for enrollment, which includes; a current health inventory and immunization certificate completed by parents and child's physician, and any paperwork required by the Office of Child Care. Enrolled children must update all paperwork as needed. All paperwork must be received before your child attends.
- 11. For all new enrollments that have sign up for the summer duration, if all weeks signed up for are used and paid for, your deposit will be credited to the last week of the summer that was signed up for.
- 12. Any changes to your summer contract must be submitted in writing prior to June 1, 2019.
- 13. I have read and agree to the conditions of this contract.
