2 Tablespoons cream of tartar
I Tablespoon vegetable oil
1 cup water
1/2 Tablespoon ground cinnamon
Food Coloring

Sift together flour, salt and cream of tartar. Add to saucepan and add food coloring, water, and oil. On medium heat mixture and stir constantly.
